1 Corinthians 6:19 English Standard Version (ESV)


Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own,

- 3. The Kingdom of God is a real and present reality here and now. God is in the business of redeeming and restoring what sin broke in the world. He is looking for partners, and everyone, everywhere is invited to be a part.
- 4. The invitation of the Gospel is always toward community. We will never be truly able to experience the Kingdom of God without intentional, spiritual relationships with others.



"Since providence, which has ordered all things and is deeply interested in our life, has set in most perfect order by giving us Augustus, whom she filled with virtue that he might benefit humankind, sending him as a savior, both for us and for our descendants, that he might end war and arrange all things, and since he, Caesar, by his appearance [excelled even our expectations], surpassing all previous benefactors, and not even leaving to posterity any hope of surpassing what he has done, and since the birthday of the god Augustus was the beginning of the good news for the world that came by reason of him."

-Taken from an inscription found in Priene

This is Jesus' Message:

Matthew 9:35-38 New International Version (NIV)

Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness. When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."

Luke 4:43 New International Version (NIV)

But he said, "I must proclaim the good news of the kingdom of God to the other towns also, because that is why I was sent."

Luke 8:1 New International Version (NIV)

After this, Jesus traveled about from one town and village to another, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God. The Twelve were with him,

Luke 16:16 New International Version (NIV)

The Law and the Prophets were proclaimed until John. Since that time, the good news of the kingdom of God is being preached, and everyone is forcing their way into it.
