FESTIVAL OF FIRSTFRUITS

- Leviticus 23:9-14
- Numbers 28:26

"Barley flour, and therefore barley bread, was the poor man's staple in the First Century. Recall John 6:9, 'There was a boy with five small barley loaves...'" —E.G. Lewis
